VISION 2

- A race is assigned to your fundraising committee
- Each race has 6 dogs, so there are 720 combinations to the order in which the dogs can finish the race
- Each ticket has an individual combination printed on the ticket
- Each ticket holder also receives admission and a race programme on the night
- The ticket holder with the winning combination of the race wins a cash prize (set by the organisation)

Sell 720 tickets @ €20.00 each (admits 2 adults and 2 children)	€14,400
Sponsor donates the cash prize (appears on all tickets etc. in recognition)	€1,000

#### The simplest option, perfect for raising between C1,000 & C6,000. See how it works.

 The fundraising committee will sell tickets for a designated date (templates and design elements are provided, printing or production costs are not included) • Tickets can then be sold at €10.00 each

• The day before the event the organiser pays €3.00 for all tickets sold, and returns the remainder

Sell 400 tickets @ €10.00 per ticket	€4,000
Pay Stadium €3.00 per ticket	€750
Profit	€3,250
