Guidance on creating the Export Health Cert for exporting dogs to Great Britain

The Ireland (IE) exporter must create an **Export Health Certificate (EHC)** on TRACES, **not** an intra-EU trade certificate (ITAHC). The exporter will need to indicate the UK entry point (e.g. Liverpool) on the EHC – this is different to filling in an ITAHC.



The EHC is the 5th option on the left-hand side menu (circled in red below). Click 'new'
