All samples where a prohibited substance was detected by the Laboratory were referred to the Control Committee for determination and Bord na gCon notes that in all cases of a positive adjudication for a prohibited substance, details have been published by the Control Committee up to and including cases heard in June 2014.

To ensure all samples are dealt with in an expedient manner, Bord na gCon has modified its procedures, by removing from the process the Track Inquiry conducted by Control Stewards concerning samples that return a positive result, thus streamlining the time from when the sample result is notified to the Owner/Trainer to when the matter is referred to the Control Committee.
